## Professional focus BSc05

#### Learning activities

- Different methods are used in different courses.

  - Forest industry, forest management association, Finnish Forest Centre, forest research organisation etc.

### Status

- Status of the curriculum
  - First implementation was in Autumn 2023
    - Six European students
    - A number on selected Indian students
  - Second round will be in Autumn 2024
    - Lectures, exercises and field visits scheduled on weekly level

  - Specialisation studies are included in the curriculum of forestry at Karelia UAS as elective studies





## Living Lab experiences

- Future forest management: Environmental challenges induced by climate change
  - Decreased frost in soil; increased risk of pest outbreaks; tree species composition
- Carbon forestry: EU and national policy
  - Demands for forest use related to carbon management
- Forestry in a changing society: Increasing demands of various stakeholder groups to use of forests
  - Private forests; public forests owned by cities and municipalities; state forests
- Diverse uses of forests: Increasing value of non-wood forest products
